Honor The Memory of Your Loved Ones with a Sanctuary Memorial Plaque

Our tradition is to memorialize your loved one with a dedicated bronze plaque in the Sanctuary. The plaque is lit on the yahrzeit (anniversary date of death) of the departed and on Yom Kippur, as well as each time Yizkor is recited in the sanctuary.

Our clergy will officiate at the hanging of the plaque to allow you to gather for a short family ceremony and each year, prior to the anniversary date, you will receive a reminder.

The cost of \$1,800 covers the embossing of the name and the date (there is an additional charge of \$360 for the inclusion of Hebrew letters)

Approximate time of installation is eight to ten weeks from receipt of the confirmed order.
